

Crosswalk FY 2022 Construction List Released

Georgia Gwinnett College will add a crosswalk connecting both sides of the Gwinnett County Transit route 45 bus stop to the FY 2024 list of campus projects, according to Terrence Schneider, the AVP of GGC Operations.

“[A student] saw an issue and made a suggestion,” said Jacqueline Todd, Director of Public Relations, “and the college was responsive to feedback from its students. A splendid outcome!”

The stop is known on the Gwinnett County Transit (GCT) map as Lonnie Harvel and GGC stops right before the three-way stop signs, with an entrance to the faculty parking lot by B building.

The crosswalk allows students to cross safely between both sides of the bus stop, but also enter the school from a sidewalk similar to the safety features on Collins Hill Industrial Way by the Wellness and Recreation Center.

The route 45 bus line was added to [GGC in 2018](#) and runs along medical offices, businesses, and apartments before ending at Sugarloaf Mills Mall Park ‘n Ride. From there students can get on the

route 10A/B bus to the Doraville MARTA rail station to go as far as the Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

“No plans have been announced to extend MARTA rail service to Lawrenceville,” said Todd. Georgia Gwinnett College declined in joining other institutions in offering discounted student breeze cards for public transit under UPASS.

The news comes on the heels of the ninth annual Link to Lawrenceville bicycle ride celebrating the completion of a bicycle lane connecting downtown Lawrenceville to GGC, Friday, October 21st.
