The softball team earned a shutout victory and played a tough loss in a doubleheader, while the baseball team picked up two wins and a narrow loss in a series away from home. The tennis teams rested and prepared for upcoming games.

SOFTBALL

April 13 – Vs. Thomas was a 2-0 shutout. The Grizzlies held strong to gain a win in a competitive game against Thomas. Morgan McQuagge's hit in the sixth inning helped the team take the lead with a two-run advantage. Angelica Gallegos helped the team keep the lead by making 14 putouts and an

assist. Annalise Jarvis kept the opposition batters out of the game and led the Grizzlies' defensive efforts by tossing 14 strikeouts throughout all seven innings.

April 13 – Vs. Thomas was a 0-10 loss. The team split the doubleheader against Thomas, facing a tough loss after their win in the first game. The opposing team built a large enough lead to end the game at the end of the fifth inning. Jane Hoover made six putouts, and Kailynn James tossed three strikeouts for the Grizzlies.

April 13 – At Tennessee Wesleyan was a 7-9 loss. The team led the game until the bottom of the eighth inning, when the opposition made a late rally to steal the win at the end. Despite the result, the Grizzlies put on an impressive performance at the Bulldog's home. Blaze O'Saben and Joe Quelch each scored a home run, giving the team an early advantage. Ben Harris tossed nine strikeouts in seven innings to keep the Bulldogs from taking the lead until the end of the game.
