Perfect pitches, rampant runs, and sizable scores defined this week's action in sports at Georgia Gwinnett College. The softball and baseball teams entertained with high scoring games while the tennis teams rested and prepped for the upcoming Grizzly Spring Break Invitational.

SOFTBALL

Feb. 27 – Vs. Middle Georgia State was a 3-2 win. Kloey Goins aided the team in scoring all 3 runs during the 3rd inning in Game 1 by hitting 2 RBIs. Jane Hoover made 5 putouts to help the team maintain their lead.

Feb. 27 – Vs. Middle Georgia State was a 7-0 shutout. Kailyn Berry and Annalise Jarvis left a historic impression by pitching the program's first combined no-hitter. Berry blocked out any possible hits from Middle Georgia State during the opening 4 innings before Jarvis finished the impressive feat

by tossing the last 3 innings without any hits from the opposition. Summer Hickson helped build the Grizzlies lead by hitting 3 RBIs.

Feb. 29 – Vs. Truett-McConnell was a 10-8 win. The Grizzlies held strong as they scored runs in all but one inning. Summer Hickson scored 2 runs and hit 2 RBIs to help the Grizzlies overcome a close game. Angelica Gallegos made 7 putouts. Mollie Peacock tossed a strong pitch, winning the game for the Grizzlies.

Feb. 29 – Vs. Truett-McConnell was an 8-0 shutout. Annalise Jarvis tossed a perfect game, making it the fifth time a softball pitcher has done this in program history. Jarvis has achieved this feat for the fourth time in her career. Jarvis also struck out 14 batters, while Gallegos made an equally impressive 14 putouts to defend the team's lead. Haley Robinson hit her first home run to help build the Grizzly's strong lead in this shutout against Truett-McConnell.

Through determined defensive plays and a strong offensive showing, the Grizzlies came back and won 11-6.
